Each camper must have a **physical within the last 12 months** prior to camp to comply with Colorado State Regulations. The enclosed Health and Camper Information Form (two sides) must be completed and either sent with the registration form and deposit or brought with the camper on the first day. No camper can be admitted to camp without these forms signed by a physician and parent. These forms are available at all Friends churches or on the web at www.RMYM.org.

Quaker Ridge insurance does not cover sickness or injury. We will make provision for sick campers and our medical staff will see to their comfort and care.
