

Rocky Mountain Yearly Meeting Ministry Scholarship Guidelines

1. This scholarship, funded through interest income gained from the William Williamson Trust, is to be used to aid in the preparation of full-time or part-time undergraduate or graduate students majoring in fields pertaining to ministry.
2. Applicants must provide clear, up-to-date testimonies of their conversions and/or testimonies of God's call on their lives.
3. Applicants must be members of Rocky Mountain Yearly Meeting via their local churches.
4. Applications shall be sent to the President of the RMYM Board of Christian Education Ministries, as indicated on the application form, who will review it with the Scholarship Committee.
5. The scholarship will be given to a student from Rocky Mountain Yearly Meeting who is attending a Friends college and/or a student from Rocky Mountain Yearly Meeting who is attending a seminary. The Scholarship Committee may consider a deserving student from Rocky Mountain Yearly Meeting who is preparing for full-time Christian service, but who may plan to attend a Christian college other than a Friends college, during years that a student from a Friends school does not apply.
6. The Scholarship Committee must receive three letters of reference — for example, from a pastor, teacher, a business person, or a friend. The references should be able to speak to the applicant's attributes such as Christian work and ministry, ability to work with others, character, area(s) of giftedness, etc.
7. This scholarship may be given to one or two students per year depending upon financial need. If the amount of the scholarship exceeds the amount owed on tuition, the student may use the scholarship funds for books and/or expenses for that year.
8. The final awarding of the scholarship will be subject to discussion and approval of the Rocky Mountain Yearly Meeting Board of Christian Education Ministries.
9. Scholarship funds will be sent directly to the financial aid office of the educational institution the student will be attending.
