

**Guidelines For Scholarship
Rocky Mountain Yearly Meeting**

Missions Board

1. **This RMYM Missions Board scholarship is to provide assistance for college costs to prepare for evangelical Friends mission service. This scholarship could also be used by a current missionary who wishes to flutter their education.**
2. **The student applying for a Missions scholarship must be a full-time upper class college student (Junior / senior).**
3. **He/she must give a clear and up-to-date testimony of a born-again experience.**
4. **He/she must give a definite witness — to God’s calling into missionary service, which would include ministerial training, evangelism, multiplying small groups, starting house churches, leadership development and Christian Education.**
5. **He/she should preferably be a member of Rocky Mountain Yearly Meeting. If there are no applicants from RMYM, consideration may be given to a qualified applicant front another Evangelical Friends yearly meeting who is planning to enter evangelical Friends mission service.**

(It is preferred that the Scholarship be given to a student from RMYM attending a Friends college or a student front RMYM attending seminary. The Scholarship Committee has the liberty to consider a deserving student from RMYM preparing for full-time missions work that may be attending a Christian College or seminary other than a Friends school in years that a student from a Friends school does not apply.)
- & **He/she shall send an application to the Scholarship Committee chairperson before the announced deadline.**
7. **The student should be willing, if possible, to do on-the-job training at Rough Rock, EFI/NA missions program, etc., for a period of time.**
8. **The Scholarship Committee must receive letters of reference from a pastor, a teacher, a business person and a friend.**
9. **This scholarship is for one student, \$375 per semester, or \$750 per year, depending upon the setup of the school he/she attends.**
10. **If several students are applying for the scholarship, it is preferable to give the scholarship to one qualified student.**
11. **The final awarding of the scholarship would be subject to discussion and approval of the RMYM Missions Bard.**
